- Indoor/Outdoor

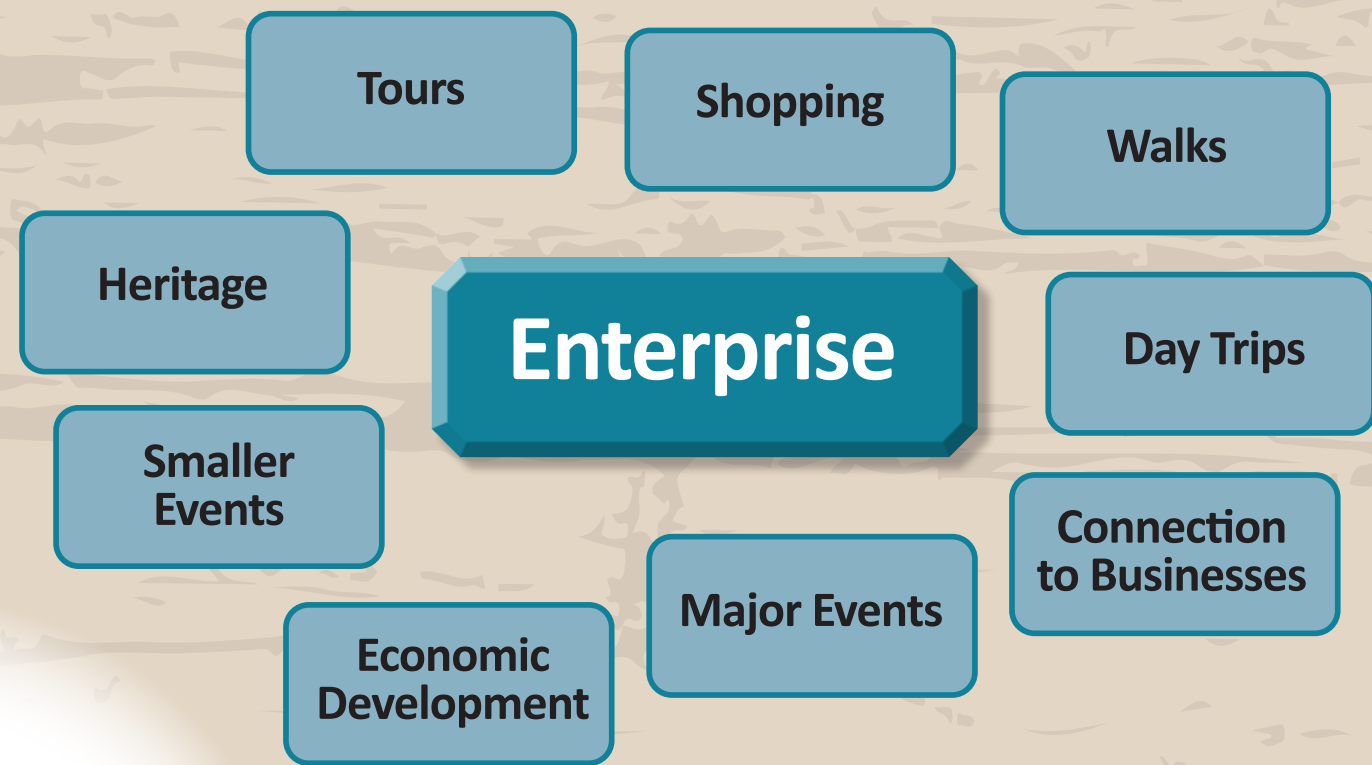
